**The vision of the IDIH project is to pioneer a transnational approach to global challenges in Active and Healthy Ageing (AHA). The international Digital Health Transformation Forum gathers top-notch experts from EU and the 5 Strategic Partner Countries, with the aim to:**

- Develop a Roadmap with concrete measures for enhancing collaboration in priority areas
- Pave a path that overcomes fragmentation in R&I Investments in AHA
- Tackle system biases in AHA e.g., in terms of gender, regions, cultures etc.
- Generate impact from EU and international programmes
- Target future trends and drivers of high impact and disruption in AHA
